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America's top young skiers arrive in Alaska for the 2019 U.S. Ski & Snowboard Cross Country Junior National Championships *Racing begins March 11, concludes March 16 at Kincaid Park*

ANCHORAGE, AK – More than 400 of America's best young cross-country skiers will compete for national titles at the 2019 U.S. Ski & Snowboard Cross Country Junior National Championships, which begin Monday, March 11, and continue through Saturday, March 16. All races take place at Kincaid Park.

The week of racing includes four events for young men and women: the individual freestyle (Monday, March 11), the classic sprint (Wednesday, March 13), the mass start classic (Friday, March 15), and the relay freestyle (Saturday, March 16). There are three racing divisions per gender – U20 (Ages 18-19), U18 (Ages 16-17) and U16 (Ages 14-15). The top American finisher in each race division will be crowned national champion. The top team will win the Alaska Cup.

More than 400 athletes and 100 coaches, countless parents and family members, and more than 200 volunteers join premier title sponsor ConocoPhillips Alaska and many other sponsors and organizations in fueling this year's event. There are 10 teams/divisions representing multiple states/regions at this year's event: host Team Alaska; defending Alaska Cup champs New England; Pacific Northwest; Far West; Rocky Mountain; Intermountain; Midwest; Great Lakes; High Plains; and Mid-Atlantic.

Junior Nationals come to Alaska in five-year rotations, splitting between Fairbanks and Anchorage: they last took place in Fairbanks in 2013 and in Anchorage in 2008.
